History of the Canadian Meat Goat Association...

In 1995, the Canadian Boer Goat Association was officially incorporated by Agriculture Canada under the Animal Pedigree Act, with official by-law approval coming in 1996. This approval provided



sole authority as the only association approved to register Boer and Boer-cross goats in Canada. Eventually the CBGA began self-registry out of the Association office in Glenwood, Alberta.

In 2001, the Association office was relocated to eastern Ontario, and bilingual services became available to Francophone

producers. Since then, the Association has been working hard to offer all of its written materials, including the quarterly Canadian Meat Goat Journal and the website, in both official languages.

In 2004, the membership of the CBGA voted to change its name to the Canadian Meat Goat Association (CMGA) and to expand its mandate to the broader meat goat industry in Canada. Since then, the Association has been developing educational and marketing tools for both commercial meat goat and purebred seed stock producers.

In 2009, the Association office was

relocated to Saskatchewan, and the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation (CLRC) in Ottawa was contracted to process registrations and memberships.

In 2013, the CMGA received official approval from Agriculture Canada to become the only registering body for Kiko goats in this country.

The Association depends on the commitment of its volunteer Board and committee members, who keep its many programs running.




