1. Divisions are listed as: Purebred Does, Percentage Does, Purebred Bucks, Commercial Does, and Market Kids for both Boer and Kiko breeds.
2. The CMGA will supply rosettes for Junior Champion and Reserve, Senior Champion and Reserve and the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion of each division. All other ribbons, trophies and awards are the responsibility of the individual show committee.
3. Includes Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Certificates must be purchased if not purchasing rosettes.
4. All divisions from one breed must be presented at a national show. National show rosettes will be supplied for grand and reserve champions.
5. A late fee will apply for all late applications. The CMGA has to evaluate if rosettes can be supplied on time for the show. If this is not possible, certificates will be sent.
